## STATEMENT

The three **Human Rights Party** members of the National Assembly are going to boycott today's National Assembly meeting to show HRP opposition to the withdrawal or suspension of parliamentary immunity.

**Human Rights Party** does disagree to the withdrawal or suspension of the immunity of Mr. Sam Rainsy who has expressed or acted to defend people and nation's interest.

**Human Rights Party** finds that all MPs' parliamentary immunity, regardless of whether the immunity is the opposition party's or the ruling one's, is the privilege given to the members of parliament so that they can rightfully serve and protect the will of people without any unreasonable arrest, detention or custody because members of parliament, fulfilling their roles, have to act and express their opinion more than ordinary people do.

**Human Rights Party** considers the unreasonable withdrawal, suspension or lift of immunity as the lack of respect for the immunity, the members of parliament and the will of people, affecting the principle of multi-party democracy and national development.
