Phnom Penh, 22 January 2010

Statement

Today, 22 January 2010, is the sixth anniversary of the death of Mr. Chea Vichea, well-known president of Free Trade Union, who was shot dead by very cruel assassins while reading newspaper at the back of Lanka Pagoda. A few days following his death, accused of killing Mr. Chea Vichea, two men Mr. Sok Someoun and Mr. Bon Somnang were arrested by the competent authorities. In spite the fact that the two people were proved not guilty by national and international organizations, they were still sentenced to five years in prison. Six years has passed, but the real criminals have not been brought to justice yet, and the competent authorities are always saying they are investigating the case. What they have been saying is unbelievable since so far there have been many criminal cases in which the criminals have committed the crime with impunity.

As a political party which upholds non-violent method in dealing with the issues of the nation, Human Rights Party (HRP) strongly refuses all forms of violence and urges the competent authorities as well as the government to arrest all the assassins and bring charges against all of them. By doing so, the Kingdom of Cambodia will have a real peace since impunity will not bring harmony to Cambodia.
